INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME**

IB PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Morgan Park High School International Baccalaureate program is a rigorous academic program open to highly motivated students who reside in Region 6.

The program offers a two-year (11th and 12th grade) international curriculum. All IB Diploma candidates engage in the study of languages, science, math and humanities in the final two years of their secondary schooling.

To prepare students for the rigors of the IB Diploma experience, Morgan Park offers an IB Preparatory Program with advanced level classes in core subject areas for 9th and 10th grade students.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Stanines of 6 or higher in both reading and total math.
- Minimum Explore Scores of 17 in Reading and Mathematics
- Reside in CPS Region 6 – *south of 83rd street.*
- Exemplary 7th and 8th grade report cards in academics, conduct and attendance.

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Complete the application and submit it along with copies of your 7th grade ISAT scores, 7th grade report card, and 8th **grade report card for the first marking period**. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.
2. Hand-deliver or mail (no FAXES) completed applications to Morgan Park by Friday, December 18, 2009. (If you are using CPS Mail Run, allow at least 4 school days for delivery.) Mail applications to:
