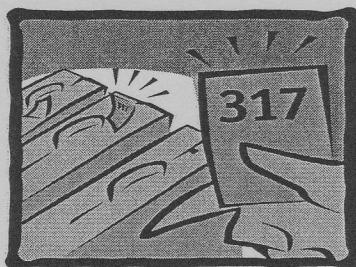

## What is the **LOTTERY** and who can apply?

*Morgan Park High School* accepts incoming freshman based on an attendance area lottery. Students that reside in Morgan Park High Schools' attendance area may submit a lottery card providing their parent and/or guardian can present proof of residency. Proofs of residency may be, but are not limited to, a picture i.d., such as driver's license or State identification, a utility bill, car insurance, pay stubs or Medicaid. Lottery applications can be completed at Morgan Park High during the Open House or on Tuesdays-Thursdays between 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

The lottery cards are numbered in the order that they are received. The lottery cards are placed in a lottery drum and are selected randomly as the drum is turned. When selected, the lottery number and the students name will be called. The student does not have to be present to receive eligibility for registration. Once the designated number of lottery cards are pulled (approximately 300) letters will be sent to the parent/guardian with a specific date and time for registration.

Students are not selected based on their scores or required to test for attendance area lottery admissions. The only criteria is that the student reside in Morgan Park High Schools' attendance area. *Morgan Park High School is a neighborhood attendance area school.*

Open House for the 2010 incoming freshman is scheduled for October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

The deadline for submission of lottery cards is December 18th, 2009.

The attendance area lottery for the school year 2010-2011 will be held January 13; 2010 at 9:00 a.m. at Morgan Park High School in the social room.
